

Political Prisoners

Aria and Sepehr Azdari, two brothers from Yasuj, were arrested on January 10. Security forces raided the gym where they were training and detained them.

During the raid, security cameras were confiscated and those present were violently assaulted. Aria Azdari, who has a heart condition, was shocked with a stun gun during his arrest.

Sepehr Azdari is an Asian powerlifting champion and a graduate of physical education.

Since their arrest, no clear information has been released about the brothers' condition.

Their grandmother suffered a heart attack after learning of the arrests and the lack of news.

She passed away on January 25.



Iran's Immortal Names

Mahan Haghighi, a young wrestler and a provincial championship title holder, was killed on the evening of Thursday, 18 Dey, in the city of Rasht, after being shot with live ammunition by regime agents

The agents fired a bullet at his skull, and Mahan Haghighi lost his life in front of his family home

Dr. Ahmad Ghorbani is a pharmacist based in Shahin Shahr, Isfahan Province.

During the 2025 national uprising, he distributed masks among protesters.

When tear gas was used, he replaced masks for those affected. He reportedly took full responsibility for these actions and for the team

working with him.

It is also reported that pellet gun injuries were treated in a veterinary clinic.

He has been detained for three weeks and there is no information about his current condition

Killing of Children by the Islamic Republic

According to Hengaw, on Friday 19 Dey 1404, **Anila Aboutalebian**, an 8 year old girl from Isfahan, was shot dead by government forces.

She was returning home with her mother when security forces stopped their car. After the vehicle attempted to change route, forces ordered it to

They then opened fire on the car, killing the child.

Following the killing, the family was placed under intense security pressure.

Anila's mother later attempted suicide amid these pressures.



News of the Day

The return of suspicious student deaths raises serious concern.

Yesterday, the deaths of Farhad Salari and Erfan Taherkhani, top medical students at the University of Tehran, were reported. Both lived in the university dormitory and their bodies were found by other students a day later. Evidence points to suspicious deaths inside their dorm rooms. Some have claimed the deaths were suicides. Given the Islamic Republic past record of similar deaths during the Mahsa Uprising, this explanation cannot be accepted with certainty.
