


## Political Prisoners

**Pedram Alamdari**, a physics student at the University of Tabriz and editor in chief of the suspended student publication Yool, was arrested at his home by security forces on Sunday afternoon, February 1. His family has not been given any information about the charges against him.



## News of the Day

In the early hours of Thursday, February 5, 2026, at least 15 prisoners were executed in multiple prisons across Iran.

The executions were carried out in facilities including Damghan, Chabahar, Mashhad, Bushehr, and several other cities nationwide.

HRANA reported the identities of those executed, confirming the widespread and coordinated nature of the executions. Human rights organizations state that the Islamic Republic systematically uses the death penalty as a tool of intimidation and repression. They warn that mass and frequent executions are aimed at silencing society rather than delivering justice.

## Iran's Immortal Names

According to a report by Hengaw, on Thursday, January 8, 2026, Amirreza Kermajani, a 22 year old Kurdish citizen from Kermanshah (Kermashan), was killed by direct gunfire from government security forces during popular protests in Fardis, Karaj. Amirreza Kermajani was laid to rest on Monday, January 12, 2026.



## Children Targeted by Bullets

### Killing of Children by the Islamic Republic

Fifteen year old Baluch child Mohammad Reza Darzadeh from Chabahar was injured by security forces during the nationwide protests in Chabahar on January 8, 2026. He was arrested and, after 27 days, remains in an unknown legal status with no information available about his health condition.



## When the Law Falls Silent

A lawyer representing Baluch prisoners sentenced to death has written about the failure of all legal efforts and his complete loss of faith in Iran's judicial system.

Introducing himself as the **lawyer of Abdulrahim Ghanbarzehi Gargij**, he says this is not a legal defense but a human farewell, written in defense of dignity and humanity.

He describes his clients as human beings with lives and families, not just legal cases, and expresses deep exhaustion from injustice and false human rights claims.
